

Umrah Requirements

Documents must be submitted at least 3 weeks prior to departure date.

Check List for Umrah:

- A passport that's valid for at least 6 months with 3 or 4 blank pages for each traveler
- Umrah Visa application form– Signed (download from our website under FORMS section)
- Applicable check amount as advised by agent depending on your package
- 2 passport size photographs against a plain white back ground
- Immunization Card showing vaccination for Meningitis
- Meningitis and POLIO record for children under 15 years old.
- Husband-Wife_ Marriage certificate in English or Arabic
- Children Birth certificates showing parents name
- If applicant is not a U.S citizen, a copy of your Green card, or copy of legal status in U.S.A as accepted by Saudi Consulate. B1/B2 visa are not permitted. For other visa types call us.
- The Mahram should write his complete information on the application forms of his spouse and children or any relative with whom he is traveling. He should also provide copies of marriage or birth certificates.
- All women are required to travel for Umrah with a Mahram. Proof of kinship must be submitted with the application form. Women over the age of forty-five (45) may travel without a Mahram with a group, they must, however submit a no objection letter from her husband, son or brother authorizing her to travel for Umrah with the named group. This letter should be notarized.
- Umrah visas will only be granted once the authorities in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia have approved the applicant's request.

Other mandatory requirements:

- Pilgrims must have confirmed Hotel reservation for entire stay duration in KSA.
- Transportation from Airport to Makkah/Madina and return
- Above items has to be booked & confirmed by Tour operators authorized by Ministry of Hajj
